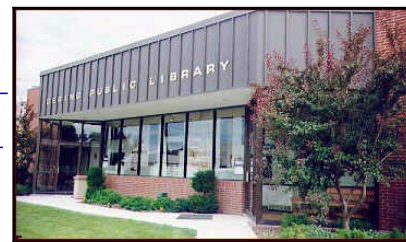

This museum is housed in the old Burlington Railroad Depot, built in 1928. The quaint brick structure was all but abandoned by Burlington Northern Railroad Company in the 1990's. In 1994, volunteers wanting to preserve the history of the old railroad and sugar beet factory town decided to convert the old depot into a museum. It opened for its first season in 1999 and is filled with many historical items relating to Bayard, Chimney Rock, and the Valley, including horse-drawn machinery. It has won 2 awards already in its short existence.
